General Order 2015-01 February 16, 2015

To: District Staff, Unit Commanders, and Unit Adjutants,

Pursuant to the issuance of SUVCW General Order \$15\$ by Commander in Chief Tad Campbell, which directs all subordinate organizations of the SUVCW to send copies of their by-laws to the National Treasurer of the SUVCW, I have received numerous inquiries about how to comply with the order from some members of the 6th Military District. Through my conversations with the National SVR Adjutant General, Colonel Donald Darby, he has provided the following guidance:

- 1. The National Staff of the SVR has concluded that few if any of the SVR units under its command have written separate by-laws.
- 2. The Commanding General of the SVR, Major General Robert Grim, has informed the National Secretary and the National Treasurer of the SUVCW that SVR Units and SVR Districts not having separate written by-laws fall under the umbrella of the SVR National Constitution and by-laws and are not required to submit a separate set of by-laws to the National Treasurer of the SUVCW.
- In acknowledgment of the fact that a few SVR units have adopted by-laws; those by-laws may be submitted, however they should ensure that they are written within the constraints of the National SVR Constitution-Regulations and by-laws.

Thus it is hereby directed that all units of the 6<sup>th</sup> Military District abide by the guidance provided in #1-3 above by the National Headquarters of the SVR.

In the event of changes to this guidance, 6<sup>th</sup> Military District Headquarters will issue additional notices and District Orders to its members and unit commanders
