Sons of Veterans Reserve General Order 2015-02

National Treasurer Richard Orr, PCinC, and SVR Staff have revealed practices operating within the SVR that need to be swiftly addressed and corrected.

To clarify:

- 1. SVR units are subordinate to the District and the National Military Department (NMD) only. Camps are subordinate to the Department.
- 2. Both the Department and NMD are subordinate to the SUVCW National Order and maintain two distinct paths of command and control.
- 3. SVR units are chartered by the NMD, while Camps are chartered by the National Organization. Their authority to exist emanates from different sources and with different requirements and regulations.

Although stated explicitly in neither the SUVCW Constitution & Regulations nor the SVR Regulations, it is a matter of Federal law that SVR units and SUVCW Camps do not comingle funds. They are separate and independent organizations and need to be managed as such.

Effective April 2nd, 2015 all SVR units shall neither share funds with any camp nor share an Employee Identification Number (EIN) with any camp. If any SVR unit is currently employing a Camp's EIN for purposes of reporting, this is to cease immediately and an EIN in the name of said unit needs to be created by applying to the IRS without delay.

Failure to comply with this order will result in suspension from the SVR and all SVR activities until the situation is rectified to the satisfaction of National SVR Staff.
